"BUILDING SUSTAINABLE HEALTHCARE LEADERS: INTEGRATING SDGS INTO HEALTHCARE MANAGEMENT CURRICULUM"

Integrating Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) into healthcare management curriculum necessitates a pedagogical approach that not only educates future healthcare leaders but also equips them with the tools to address global health challenges sustainably. For instance, aligning learning objectives with specific SDGs, such as incorporating modules on universal health coverage to support SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-being), ensures that students grasp the importance of accessible and affordable healthcare services. Moreover, an interdisciplinary approach encourages collaboration among healthcare management, public health, and environmental studies faculties, as seen in a case study where students analyze the environmental impact of healthcare facilities (SDG 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities) while considering the health implications (SDG 3). Project-based learning initiatives, like developing sustainable healthcare delivery models for underserved communities (SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities), empower students to apply management principles in addressing healthcare disparities. Experiential learning opportunities, such as internships in global health organizations working on disease prevention and control (SDG 3), provide students with practical insights into the complexities of public health challenges. Integrating technology, such as utilizing telemedicine platforms to improve access to healthcare services (SDG 3), enhances students' understanding of innovative solutions to healthcare delivery. By incorporating these pedagogical strategies into healthcare management curriculum, educators can cultivate a new generation of leaders who are not only proficient in managing healthcare systems but also committed to advancing sustainable development in global health.

RECENT ADVANCEMENTS AND TRENDS IN THE MEDICAL FIELD AS OF -Ms. Manasa Niverda S

The clinical area remains dynamic in the delivery of care, treatment, and education in the context of clinical areas of specialty. As such the year 2024 has seen first-rate of advancement and new traits that have influenced the manner in which care is delivered, rendered, and received.

Another one of the maximum gigantic developments is the progression of the guide of artificial intelligence (AI) generation in diagnostics and treatment of various clinical problems, inclusive of hepatocellular carcinoma (Mokhria& Singh, 2022). This is due to the reality the style of the sphere by AI potential manifested within increased functionality of data processing and analysis consequently increased accurate and individualised treatment tactics. The integration described by Bajwa et al., in Cognitive and Behavioural Practice, 2021 can potentially transform the exercise of drugs into a less imprecise, more individualized, exact, and transportable proposition.

Another significant trend in the medical world specifically in pharmacology is the trend towards more individualized and targeted medication. Thus, given the fact that the healthcare sector has advanced in its ability to make genomic sequencing, it is now feasible to deliver personalized treatments that are available to individual patient counterparts, besides their genetic endowment, lifestyle parameter, and a number of impacts influencing the body.

Over the past few years, the use of Wearable Healthcare Devices(WHDs) as a means of maintaining and managing personal health status has changed the perception of personal health monitoring and management. Products including wearables, be it fitness trackers or complex biosensors, have not only brought about convenience in terms of accessing healthcare, but also in how the user, interacts with their vital information. Since physiological and chemometric signs can be recorded, the wearable technology allows one to understand human health instead of addressing it as a sickness, thus making health care more anticipatory rather than being merely responsive.

Furthermore, the COVID-19, has enhanced even more the use of techniques such as telemedicine and home healthcare services through which patients can seek healthcare services from their doctors without physically moving from their homes.

However, as has been stated before, ideas such as tailor made and targeted medicine does indeed appear promising but it has its downside portion to the issues such as violation and abuse of privacy and data protection, distribution of limited resources inappropriately as well as even adding to the diversification of healthcare inequality. Al, along the same vein, Telemedicine and other forms of remote healthcare solutions are prevalent and still, the advancement centralizes cybersecurity has to be a strength and whoever is to be endowed with the new technologies has to be pre-informed of digital expertise.

In conclusion, the medical field has come a long way. It has registered significant advancements as well as trends in 2024 concerning usage of intelligence about medicine, precision as well as personalized medicine and the advancement of telemedicine healthcare system facilities. Such innovations pose the potential to deliver improved and efficient health solutions and care to patients. Careful planning is required as these advancements are welcomed ones however the healthcare providers, policymakers, and the rest of the extensive medical community need to share common goals and methodologies to address risks and challenges efficiently while focusing the benefits on the patient and no one else patient safety is the paramount underscored here.



Rationale for the programme

The healthcare industry in India is rapidly growing, with multi-million dollar investments made by various national and international agencies, the pharmaceutical sector, central and state governments, and developmental partners. The hospital industry in India is expected to grow at CAGR of 16-17 percent to reach to a record US\$132 billion by FY 2022 from US\$ 62 billion in FY 2017. The High Level Committee Report on Universal Health Coverage in India, 2011, recommended "strengthening health sector management by supporting post-graduate courses in public health and hospital management for the health professionals and health program management for medical, dental, AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy), nursing, and allied health professionals".

The growing demand for healthcare programme can also be justified by a fact that the number of hospitals grows rapidly across the country. There are 795 Hospitals (except clinics) in Tamil Nadu alone where 292 Hospitals are found in Chennai. In order to respond to this growth, there is a need to create human resource capacities in the areas of public health management and hospital administration. Though the process of building human resource capacities in healthcare management has already started, there is still scope for a lot of learning and education, in order to achieve the objective of a strong healthcare management workforce. Keeping the demand into consideration, many institutions (about 122 in India and 5 in Tamil Nadu) offer hospital and public health management related courses at different levels. 
