"THE ECONOMICS OF LOVE, RELATIONSHIPS, AND MENTAL HEALTH: FINDING BALANCE IN LIFE"

In economics, the Law of Variable Proportions explains how output changes when we vary one input while keeping others constant. Initially, increasing an input (like labor) boosts output, but beyond a certain point, the returns diminish. This principle, while rooted in production, surprisingly mirrors aspects of life—especially in relationships, love, and student mental health. At first glance, economics might seem far removed from our personal lives. But when we apply the Law of Variable Proportions—a principle that governs production—we discover striking parallels with love, relationships, and student mental health. This law explains how increasing one input while keeping others constant can initially improve output, but after a certain point, the returns begin to diminish. Understanding this concept can offer profound insights into how we manage our relationships and mental well-being.

The Phase of Growth Think of the early days of a relationship, where small actions—sending a thoughtful message or spending quality time together—lead to a growing bond. Similarly, when students first dive into their studies, dedicating more time yields better results. These are the "increasing returns" phases, where every additional effort leads to noticeable improvements.

The Plateau However, there's a limit to how much we can give or take before the benefits level off. Excessive attention in a relationship might feel overwhelming. For students, relentlessly studying without breaks leads to diminishing focus and retention. This is the "constant returns" phase, where the additional effort yields little to no added value.

The Decline Pushing beyond balance leads to stress, burnout, or strained connections—the "diminishing returns" phase. Over-investing time in one area, whether it's a relationship or academics, at the expense of mental health, can have negative outcomes.

The Takeaway The Law of Variable Proportions teaches us an important life lesson: balance is essential. Just as economists seek the optimal mix of inputs to maximize output, students and individuals in relationships must find harmony. Investing in quality over quantity—be it in love, friendships, or self-care—ensures sustainable happiness and growth.

In our increasingly busy lives, this principle is a reminder that more is not always better. True success—whether in academics, love, or personal health—comes from moderation, mindfulness, and an awareness of when to step back and recharge. Balancing our inputs ensures we avoid burnout and achieve long-term fulfilment.



Rationale for the programme

The healthcare industry in India is rapidly growing, with multi-million dollar investments made by various national and international agencies, the pharmaceutical sector, central and state governments, and developmental partners. The hospital industry in India is expected to grow at CAGR of 16-17 percent to reach to a record US\$132 billion by FY 2022 from US\$ 62 billion in FY 2017. The High Level Committee Report on Universal Health Coverage in India, 2011, recommended "strengthening health sector management by supporting post-graduate courses in public health and hospital management for the health professionals and health program management for medical, dental, AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy), nursing, and allied health professionals".

The growing demand for healthcare programme can also be justified by a fact that the number of hospitals grows rapidly across the country. There are 795 Hospitals (except clinics) in Tamil Nadu alone where 292 Hospitals are found in Chennai. In order to respond to this growth, there is a need to create human resource capacities in the areas of public health management and hospital administration. Though the process of building human resource capacities in healthcare management has already started, there is still scope for a lot of learning and education, in order to achieve the objective of a strong healthcare management workforce.
